- 2. Papers should be no more than 20 pages or 5,000 words in length, with an abstract of no more than 100 words.
- **3.** Acceptance notification will be sent by <u>10 September 2008</u>. The Conference Secretariat must receive final revised manuscripts, by <u>30 September 2008</u>.
- **4.** The author(s) must certify that the accepted paper is not copyrighted and has not been published elsewhere.
- 5. Papers will be arranged for presentation and publication ONLY if at least one of the authors registers for the Conference by the registration deadline, <u>30 September 2008</u>.
- 6. An individual author may not appear on more than three papers.

Conference Proceedings

Papers will be double-blind reviewed for publication in the Conference Proceedings. Accepted papers will be included in the Conference Proceedings only if the authors register with the Conference by the deadline.

Official Language

Papers and presentations should be in English.
