Class/Examination Arrangements during Bad Weather

Special arrangements will be made to classes and examinations if tropical cyclone warning, rainstorm warning or "Extreme Conditions" announcement is issued or about to be issued. Students should take note of these arrangements and look out for notices posted on eCampus or the website of the Registry during bad weather.

The arrangements during bad weather are applicable to all classes, assignments, assessments and examinations, irrespective of the formats in which they are delivered or arranged.

Detailed arrangement for the postponed examinations will be announced by the Registry in due course.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.1/No.3

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.1 or No.3 is issued, classes or examinations will continue or be held as scheduled.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above or "Extreme Conditions" Announcement

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No.8 or above, or "Extreme Conditions" Announcement is issued/ lowered, or announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that such a warning/announcement is likely to be issued within the next two hours at any time specified below, arrangements for classes and examinations will be as follows:
